- Strategic Sector Cooperation (since 2015 in Turkey and South Africa)

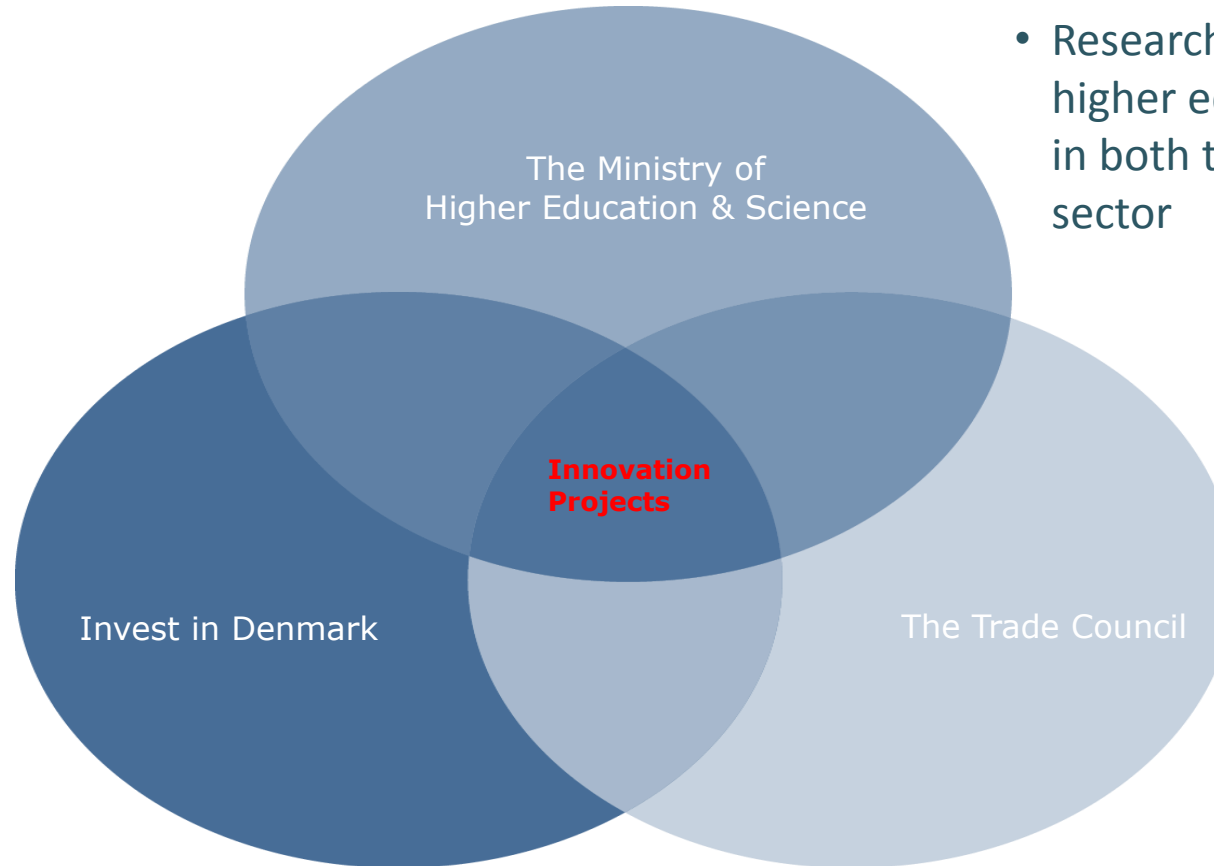

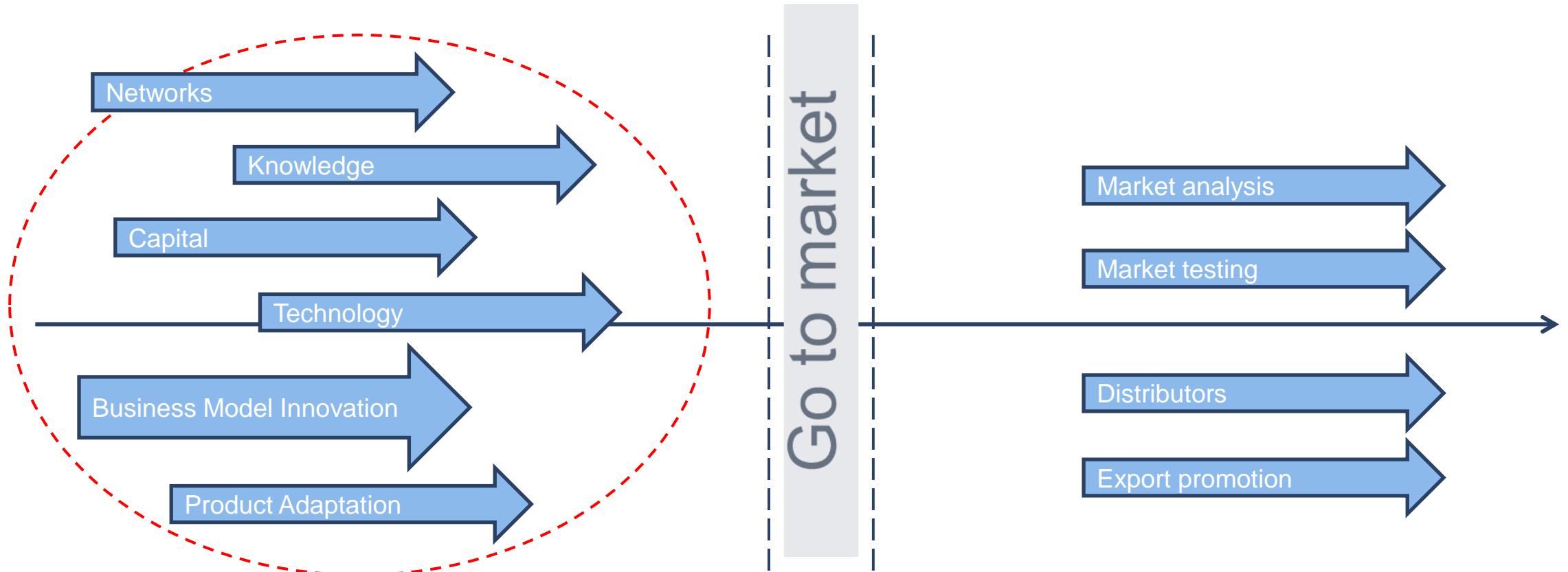

Danish-Brazilian collaboration in science, innovation and higher education

- Since 2011 a **bilateral agreement at ministerial level** (MEC/CAPES and MCTI/CNPq) → facilitating concrete networking activities
- Since 2011 a dedicated **science and innovation attaché** in São Paulo → supporting Danish researchers and institutions locally
- Since 2011 research funding through **FAPESP / Innovation Fund DK**
- Danish participation in **Science without Borders** (230 scholarships - + 100 full PhD or postdoc's)
- A large number of scientific workshops, networking activities and more



Collaboration opportunities DK-Brazil

Sources for funding of scientific collaboration are unfortunately few

- **FAPESP/ Innovation Fund Denmark**
- **DASTI's International Networking Programme** (new, explorative networks)
- **EU's Horizon 2020**; Bilateral calls, ERC, Marie Curie – some matching funds from Brazilian CONFAP/FAP's: currently São Paulo, Minas Gerais, Santa Catarina, DF – on their way perhaps Rio de Janeiro, Mato Grosso do Sul, Bahia, Espirito Santo, Sergipe and Paraíba.
